Jesus' Teaching on Prayer
(Matthew 6.9-13; 7.7-11)

One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples. Jesus said to them, "When you pray, say this: 'Father: May Your holy name be honored; may your Kingdom come. Give us day by day the food we need. Forgive us our sins, for we forgive everyone who does us wrong. And do not bring us to hard testing." And Jesus said to his disciples, "Suppose one of you should go to a friend's house at and say to him, 'Friend, let me borrow three loaves of bread. A friend of mine who is on a trip has just come to my house, and I don't have any food for him!' And suppose your friend should answer from inside, 'Don't bother me! The door is already locked, and my children and I are in bed. I can't get up and give you anything.' Well, what then? I tell you that even if he will not get up and give his friend, yet he will get up and give you everything you need because you are not ashamed to keep on asking. And so I say to you: Ask, and you will receive; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks will receive, and he who seeks will find, and the door will be opened to anyone who knocks. Would any of you who are fathers give your son a snake when he asks for fish? Or would you give him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? As bad as you are, you know how to give good things to your children. How much more, then, will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. 2 Corinthians 12:9

Paul tells us that when we are weak, we are actually stronger because of God's power working in us. Paul didn't like being weak and neither do we. As Paul

did, we need to put our trust in God, depending on God to give us what we need.

Most of us have some kind of "thorn." Paul pleaded with God three times to take his thorn away, but God said, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." God had a lesson to teach Paul and us, using the thorn as a way to show that God's power works in us when we are weak. Speaking before a large group of people is difficult for me, but when I depend on God, I'm able to do it.

God's gift of grace is much more than we deserve and greater than we imagine. God sees us as a beloved child and nothing we do or don't do will ever separate us from God's love.

Grace is the unexpected good news that, instead of meting out the punishment we deserve, Jesus offers us undeserved and unparalleled blessings. Imagine that you have been pulled over for speeding. If you get a ticket, that's justice. If you're given a warning, that's mercy. If you're given a lottery ticket as a reminder not to speed and that ticket turned out to be a winner, that's grace.

Prayer: God of Healing, I pray for your divine grace to meet our needs especially when we don't deserve it. Amen.
