### A Spirit of Unity

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Jesus so that with one heart and mind you may glorify God. Romans 15:5

A V-formation is used when geese and ducks migrate south to a warmer climate. The V-formation is used because of two important reasons: 1) it conserves their energy and 2) it is easier to keep track of every bird in the group. Birds take turns being in front, falling back when they are tired. Fighter pilots often use this formation too.

We don't use the V-formation when we meet on boards, committees, and council, but the same ideas also apply. By working together rather than individually, we conserve energy and we keep track when someone is absent.

God loves it when we work together, listening to each other's ideas and sharing our own ideas. Whatever we do, our main purpose should always be to glorify God, as we each do our part in whatever task needs to be accomplished.

In the Bible verse above, God gives us endurance and encouragement as we follow Jesus with one heart and mind glorifying God.
